High Performance Management Training with NAHRO

You'll have the opportunity to experiment with critical tools and techniques to effectively manage and supervise your teams.

As part of this training, you will receive a link to complete the TTI DISC assessment (a \$85 value). You will complete your assessment and receive your personal DISC assessment report prior to the first day of training. The DISC assessment report provides insight into your personal behavioral style. Learning about your personal style and the styles of those you work with, you can improve communication, increase understanding, and improve overall performance. During this class, we'll explore your individual DISC style and how it can help you become a High Performance Manager.
